## Lori Gordon Workshop

### Workshop summary:

We painted paper sheets to use as background paper. From polymer clay, we used molds and/or stamps to create a clay piece. (Sorry baked our pieces that night.) The next day, we painted our baked clay pieces.

Then, from the painted paper sheets, handmade paper (Lori had hundreds of handmade paper sheets), or our own torn-up paintings, we assembled layers in colors and textures appropriate for each clay piece. Lastly, we glued it all together on a backing or board.
